How about getting a bit of extra mileage out of the Library Project. What I was thinking of was sending bookmarks to all the branches of all the libraries that we've scaped.

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This is, really, a bigger project than it sounds like. I've crunched the numbers and those 131 libraries actually have over 1500 branches cumulative.

I was thinking of setting 20 bookmarks per branch as a good minimum number. It doesn't sound like much but 20x1500 = 30,000 bookmarks (yeah, Mickie can do basic math). Sending a little bit to a lot of places also minimizes the loss if a given branch chooses not to participate.





GenCon Indy is touted as the best 4 days of gaming and is attended by 25-30,000 people each year. Joe Navarro's New Farscape Book!

The final text has just gone to the publisher on Joe Navarro's new *Farscape* book. The name of the book is *The Creatures of Farscape, Behind the Scenes at Jim Henson's Creature Shop*, and it follows the creation of *Farscape's* myriad alien characters from the early days when the show was still called Space Chase, right through The Peacekeeper Wars.

It's packed with tons of cool art and photos, most of it in color, including a lot of stuff that's never been seen before. As a lifelong SF fan and makeup/makeup FX junkie, Joe wanted to do the kind of book he'd be intere s t e d i n b u y i n g.

The book covers the initial design phase, going all the way back to its earliest *Space Chase* Days, when most of the characters looked very different than the way they finally ended up on screen. D'Argo as a giant animatronic lizard? Zhaan a male Buddhist monk-type? Scorpius a multi-legged insect? Some of the original art has never been seen anywhere before, mainly because it was scattered around dusty shelves in the London Creature Shop for years. Plus lots of interviews with the people who were there at the time, from producer Brian Henson to series creator Brian Henson to the original artists and designers.

Suffice to say, you'll find some photos that probably won't be seen anywhere else, a few revelations about scenes that never made it into the final product, and a couple of surprises. Joe has promised you won't be disappointed.

Oh yes, this book also has an introduction by producer, Brian Henson, and a final word by Dick Smith, arguably one of the world's greatest living makeup artists.

The release date is scheduled for October 2004, to coincide with the airdate for *Farscape: Peacekeeper Wars*.






